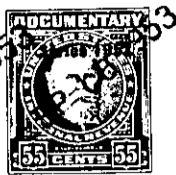

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, H. N. HESTER

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Samuel Aiken

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Samuel Aiken, his heirs and assigns forever:

All my undivided one-half interest in and to that piece parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of C. B. Wynn, Mrs B. F. McDaniel and H. N. Hester, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING on a stone on Reedy River C. B. Wynn corner; thence up River N, 36 W. 2.18 chains to a bend in Reedy River; thence N. 53 1/2 W. 6.27 chains to a bend in said River; thence N. 52 1/3 W. 5.85 chains to a bend; thence N. 34 1/2 W. 2.50 chains to a bend; thence N. 25 3/4 W. 4.40 chains to a black gum (gone) Mrs. McDaniel corner; thence with her land to an iron pin H. N. Hester's corner; thence with his line to Minie Aiken's corner; thence with her line to an iron pin on C. B. Wynn's line; thence with his line to the beginning corner on Reedy River and contains 12 acres by estimation more or less.

The interest in the above described property is the same conveyed to me by deed of John B. Hester dated October 26, 1945 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 282 at page 168.

The Grantee is to pay 1947 taxes.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Aiken,

his Heirs and Assigns forever.
