All that piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being situate on the Southerly side of Lake Fairfield Drive, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot # 89, according to plat of Section 1 of Lake Forest, prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, July, 1953, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "UG" , page 17 , and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southerly side of Lake Fairfield Drive at joint front corner of Lots # 89 and #90; thence along the joint line of those lots S. 39-21 E. 234.1 feet to a point where the joint line of those lots intersects the high water line of Lake Fairfield; thence along the high water line of the said lake, the traverse line of which is N. 62-44 E. 136.7 feet to a point where the joint line of Lots # 88 and # 89 intersects the high water line of the said lake; thence along the joint line of Lots # 88 and #89 N. 40-05 W. 265.5 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots # 88 and #89 on the Southerly side of Lake Fairfield Drive; thence along the said drive S. 49-38 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots # 89 and # 90, the point of beginning.
