That W. G. Gilreath in consideration of the sum of \$10.00 and other valuable considerations in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

PAUL LAWSON, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Township of Greenville about one and one-half (1 1/2) miles North of the County Gurt House and near the American Spinning Company Mill and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on a ten-foot alley, (sometimes called Mill Street) and running thence about North 21 1/2 East 120 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Pinckney Street North 68 1/2 West 44 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Southern Railway Company, South 38 1/2 West 129 feet to a stake on the above mentioned alley; thence along said ten-foot alley South 68 1/2 East 92 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

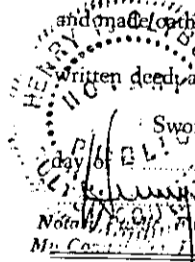

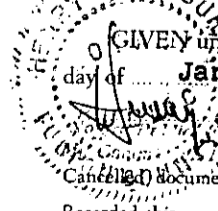
