Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, M. W. Fore in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Ninety-five & 00/100-----(\$495.00)-----DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JOHN W. WESSINGER and LOUISE WESSINGER, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 201 of Section No. 2 of a subdivision known as Caroline Court, as shown by a plat thereof, dated November, 1953, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at Page 21, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Manhattan Boulevard at joint front corners of Lots No. 202 and 201 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 202, S. 25-15 W. 240 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 214; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 214, S. 64-45 E. 100 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 200; thence along the line of said Lot No. 200, N. 25-15 E. 240 feet to iron pin on Manhattan Boulevard; thence with the said Manhattan Boulevard, N. 64-45 W. 100 feet to iron pin at point of beginning.

THAT the said lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any negro or person of African descent. No residence or business costing less than Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars, shall be erected on said lot, and no residence or building shall be erected on said lot nearer than Forty (40) feet to the front line, and no residence or business shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage. No business building shall be erected on any lot other than lots fronting on U. S. Highway No. 29.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
