complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against James Arthur Smith,
et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 20th day of November 1953,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Chester N. Wright
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear:

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master. in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$3,000.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Chester N. Wright,

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and
being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Dunklin
Township, adjoining the lands now or formerly of William Sims and Tracts
Nos. 1 and 4, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake 3x at the mouth of a branch on Keely River;
thence S. 15-45 W. 46.18 to a post oak 3x3xnm; thence N. 88-15 W. 8.08
to W. Oak 3xom; thence S. 27-30 W. 13.90 to a stake 3xm in Dunklin Bridge
Road; thence with said road to a stake 3 xnm; thence N. 27-30 E. 9.20 to
a stake 3x3xnm; thence N. 42-45 E. 14.50 to a stake 3x3xnm on a branch;
thence down said branch to an ash 3x3xnm on said river; thence with said
river to the beginning corner, containing 120 acres, more or less."
