

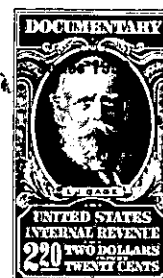

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, J. F. White,
of the County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00)

and love and affection for my daughter, the grantee, Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by Veda Bell White Heath

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Veda Bell White Heath, her heirs, and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about two miles West of the County Court House, and being a portion of a subdivision known as City View, beginning at a stake on Brandon Road, 180 feet from Oneall Street, joint corners of lots nos. 7 & 8 and running thence with joint lines of said lots in a Westerly direction, one hundred, and forty-six feet (146) to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 7, 8 & 4 A; thence in a Southerly direction 116 feet 10 inches to a stake at joint corners of Lot No. 8, and J. Frank White corner (formerly J. D. Sheppards) thence with joint lines of lot No. 8 and J. Frank White's line in an Easterly direction 160 feet to a stake on Brandon Road; thence in a Northerly direction with said Brandon Road 58 feet 9 inches to a stake at the beginning corner, same being known as Lot No. 8.
