IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED: That this easement is to be used only during the construction or repair of said pipe lines and with the exception of the right of the Grantce, its successors and assigns, agents, servants, and employees to inspect said pipe lines and to enter at any point and make re
pairs, the Grantor has the right to cultivate and use the land; provided, however, that this shall not apply to such part wherein 133-134 the top of the pipe is less than eighteen (18") inches under
ground.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED: That, as a part of the consideration thereof, the Grantor herein and the heirs and assigns of the same, may make taps or connections with said pipe lines bearing the expense thereof, privided, however, that such connections or taps be made only under the rules and supervision of the engineers representing the Grantee, its successors and assigns,
