

1 this Interlocutory Judgment and Decree, that a divorce ought to  
 2 be granted to said plaintiff from said defendant and that said  
 3 plaintiff is entitled to a divorce from said defendant on the  
 4 ground of defendant's extreme cruelty.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that at the  
 6 expiration of one year from the entry of this Interlocutory  
 7 Judgment and Decree of Divorce there may be granted a decree of  
 8 divorce finally dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between  
 9 the parties hereto.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the  
 11 care, custody and control of JOHN CARL KINSER, the minor son  
 12 of the parties hereto, be, and they are, hereby awarded to  
 13 plaintiff; subject, however, to the right of reasonable visitation  
 14 by the defendant at any and all reasonable times.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the  
 16 community property hereinafter described be, and the same is,  
 17 hereby awarded to plaintiff. Said community real property is  
 18 more particularly described as follows:

19 All that piece, parcel or lot of land in  
 20 Grant Township, Greenville County, State of  
 21 South Carolina, School District 6-A, about  
 22 six and one-half miles South of the City of  
 23 Greenville on the East side of the Augusta  
 24 Road, and being known and designated as Lot  
 25 No. 2 on a plat of the property of Albert C.  
 Taylor made by Dalton and Haven, May, 1946, and  
 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
 County in Plat Book P, page 49, and having, ac-  
 cording to said plat, the following notes and  
 bounds, to-wit:

26 Beginning at an iron pin at the Southeast  
 27 corner of Augusta Road and Branch street, and  
 28 running thence along the South side of Branch  
 29 Street, S. 53-17 E. 250 feet to a point on  
 30 the South side of Branch street at the rear  
 31 corner of Lot No. 31; thence along the East side  
 of Lot No. 31, S. 31-43 W. 97 feet to an iron  
 pin in the line of Lot No. 31 at the joint rear  
 corners of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the  
 line of Lot No. 1, N. 58-06 W. 230 feet to an  
 iron pin on the East side of Augusta Road; thence  
 along the East side of Augusta Road, N. 21-03 E.  
 100 feet to the beginning corner.
