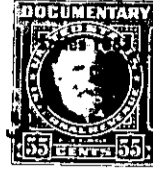

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in \_\_\_\_\_ Gantt \_\_\_\_\_ Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina lying and being situate in the Northwest corner  
of the intersection of Standing Spring road and 2nd Street in the Village  
of Conestee and having according to a Map of Air Base Farms made by  
Dalton and Neves, Engineers, November, 1944, the following metes and  
bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the center of the intersection of  
Standing Springs Road and 2nd Street and running thence with the center of  
the said 2nd Street, N 43-46 E 300 feet to an iron pin; thence E 64-29 N  
255.4 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Prebyterian property; thence  
with the said Church property S 16-40 W 268.6 feet to a point in the center  
of Standing Springs Road; thence with the center of Standing Springs Road  
S 55-14 E 101.5 feet to the beginning corner.
