in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Nine Hundred Fifty-Four and 17/100 (\$2,954.17) DOLLARS,  
and the assumption of the two mortgages set forth below,  
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

T. A. Townsend, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Welcome Avenue at the Northeasterly intersection of Welcome Avenue and Blythewood Avenue (designated as Bythewood Avenue on the recorded plat), near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as a part of Lots Nos. 86 and 87 on Map No. 2 of Camilla Park as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "M", page 85, and having according to a survey made by R. W. Dalton on October 6, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeasterly intersection of Welcome Avenue and Blythewood Avenue, and running thence along the easterly side of Blythewood Avenue N 20-36 W 180 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 87 and 88 of the recorded plat; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 87 and 88 N 69-24 E 73 feet to an iron pin; thence along a line through Lots Nos. 87 and 86 S 21-0 E 167.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northerly side of Welcome Avenue; thence along the northerly side of Welcome Avenue S 59-30 W 75 feet to the point of beginning.

For deed into grantor see Deed Book 471, page 33. For restrictions see Deed Book 277, page 326. As part of the consideration hereof the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the following mortgages standing against this property: (1) Unpaid balance of \$4,014.34 on the FHA mortgage given to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., dated October 10, 1950 and recorded in the RMC Office on the same day in Mortgage Book 479, page 224, in the original amount of \$4,500.00. (2) Unpaid balance of \$1,031.49 on the GI mortgage given to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., dated October 10, 1950 and recorded in the RMC Office on the same date in Mortgage Book 479, page 338, in the original amount of \$1,300.00, said mortgage being subordinate to the FHA mortgage set forth above. Both of these mortgages have been assigned to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company.
