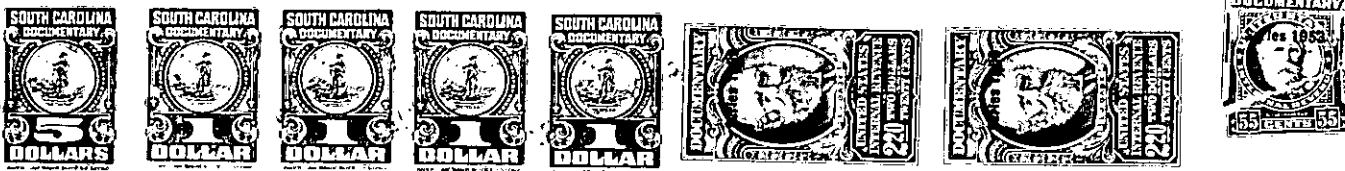
Know All Men by These Presents:

CLARK and VIRGINIA H. CLARK, Their Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the North-eastern side of Bentwood Avenue, being known and designated as a portion of Lot 11 of McCullough Heights as shown on Plat thereof by R. ... Parker, Engineer, dated 1918, recorded in Plat Book "E", page 95, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described according to a Plat by Thomas M.
