Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, T. Frank Huguenin and John T. Douglas, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty & No/100 (\$13,250.00) DOLLARS.

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Albert W. Roby, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 30 of Sherwood Forest, according to plat of Sherwood Forest recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG, pages 2-3, and having, according to a more recent plat of Property of Albert W. Roby, Jr., prepared by Dalton & Heves, Engineers, in April, 1954, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Scarlett Street, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30, which iron pin is approximately 206.56 feet from the intersection of Scarlett Street and Legrand Boulevard, and running thence S. 57-48 E. 198.1 feet to an iron pin, at the joint rear corner of Lot No. 29; thence S. 32-42 W. 65 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lot No. 31; thence N. 60-43 W. 196.7 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Scarlett Street; thence along the Eastern side of said street, N. 31-16 E. 75 feet to an iron, the point of beginning.

BEING the same property conveyed to the grantors herein by The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Substituted Trustee under Will of J. Sproull Marshall, deceased, deed dated March 1, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Vol. 430, at page 155, and by L. A. Poseley by deed dated July 17, 1953, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Vol. 482, at page 463.

The grantee herein is to pay the 1954 taxes on the above described property.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
