to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James E. Moore,

All that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, in and near the incorporate limits of the city of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No. 18 on plat of property of Donald E. Baltz recorded in plat book Y page 46 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest side of Dakota Avenue (formerly Parkins Mill Road), the front joint corner of lots 18 and 19, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 57-53 W. 151.37 feet to an iron pin in the line of lot No. 17; thence with the line of said lot N. 32-07 E. 75 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Don Drive; thence with the southwest side of said street S. 57-53 E. 136 feet to a point; thence continuing with the curve of Don Drive as it intersects with Dakota Avenue (Parkins Mill Road) S. 13-02 E. 21 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of said Avenue; thence with the northwest side of said Avenue S. 31-50 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
