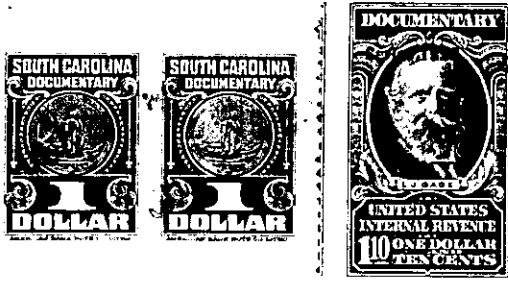

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glossy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

"All that certain lot or parcel of land in Glossy Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being situated on the east side of West Lake Shore Drive, in the Lake Shore Subdivision and more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin at the south-west corner of Lot 101 on plot of Lake Shore Subdivision made for the Lake Shore Company by George Marshaw, C. E., and dated 1907, and extending along the southern line of Lot 101 a distance of 100 feet to an iron pin on the edge of the waters of West Lake, thence N. 62° 30' W. 100 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 62° 30' W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the edge of West Lake Shore Drive, thence along Lake Shore Drive N. 31° 15' W. 100 feet to the point of beginning."
