CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

1586

WHEREAS, ROBERT B. KAY AND L. M. MOORE

both of Box 2057, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 4th. day of June, 1954, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is PLASTIC COATINGS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is sell, advertise for sale trade and deal in, as well as processing, coating, covering, fusing, treating, cleaning, painting, applying, spraying, and improving with plastics and plastics derivatives of all types and kind, household, Industrial and mercantile equipment, accessories and appliances of every kind, and, in general, to do any and all acts, operations and things in furtherance of, or incidental or conducive to, the conduct and operation of said business.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable in cash at the call of the directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Four Thousand (4,000) of the par value of One (\$1.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 21st. day of May, 1954, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

Robert P. Kay and L. M. Moore

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Robert E. Kay ; as Vice-President, L. M. Moore ; as Secretary, L. M. Moore ; as Treasurer, Robert B. Kay

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

The Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
