W. Simmons and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Jonesville Road corner of the Bramlett property; running thence along Jonesville Road, S. 59 W. 628 feet corner of Tract No. 1; thence with line of Tract No. 1, S. 19-22 E. 806.5 feet to Walnut corner of Tract No. 3; thence with line of Tract No. 3, N. 87-20 E. 419.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 41-30 E. 285.9 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Bramlett property, N. 21-40 W. 915.3 feet to the beginning corner.
