in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and No/100 (\$5.00), love and affection.....Dollars

to.....me.....in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Laura Hambright Butler, John C. Hambright and Carroll I. Hambright (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Laura Hambright Butler, John C. Hambright and Carroll I. Hambright, upon my death,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina on Whitehall Street, (formerly Whitehall Extension, just outside the City of Greenville, before extension of city limits), and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Whitehall Street Extension, corner of John Morris' lot, and running thence along Whitehall Street Extension in a Northernly direction 50 feet to a stake; thence in a Westernly direction 110 feet to a stake; thence in a Southernly direction 40 feet to a stake, Morris' line; thence along line of Morris lot in an Easternly direction 110 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO, all that piece, parcel or strip of land in Greenville Township, near Whitehall Extension, formerly outside the City of Greenville, (formerly outside the City of Greenville, before extension of city limits), and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a stake on line between the lots conveyed by J. W. Gantt to H. F. Welborn and J. J. Gresham by deed dated February 26, 1924, 38 feet West of Whitehall Extension, and running thence with the original line between said lots in a Westernly direction 72 feet to stake 40 feet from John Morris lot; thence in a Northernly direction 10 feet to stake; thence in an Easternly direction 72 feet more or less, to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that the grantees herein are to have the use of a driveway adjoining the above described lot, together with the owner, or occupant, of said adjoining property, this being a driveway common to both lots.

It is also agreed and understood that title to this property is to remain in the name of Daisy Inman Hambright during her entire lifetime and that she retains sole ownership until her demise.

The above property is that which was conveyed to me by Cecil Morris on November 24th, 1934, and recorded in Vol. 178, page 250, Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, S. C.
