in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said F. D. Lusk and Eleanor T. Lusk, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the western side of the White Horse Road near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 6 of Tract 2 of a subdivision of the property of the John B. Marshall Estate as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at pages 132 and 133, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of the White Horse Road at the corner of Lot No. 7, and running thence with the line of that lot, N. 80-30 W. 180.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-0 W. 190 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the southern side of the Easley Bridge Road; thence along the southern side of said road, N. 51-05 E. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50-00 E. 146.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of that lot, S. 80-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the western side of the White Horse Road, which point is 575 feet south from the Easley Bridge Road; thence along the western side of the White Horse Road, S. 10-15 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by F. D. Lusk and Eleanor T. Lusk by deed dated June 19, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 501, at page 518.
