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- (e) Upon the resignation or death of the trustee, a majority of the beneficiaries who are children of the grantor shall by a written recorded instrument appoint a new trustee to act who shall then have the same powers as the present trustee, George F. Tonnes;
- (f) Upon the accumulation in his hands by the trustee of an amount as one thousand dollars after paying any necessary expenses, the trustee of this trust said trustee shall pay over unto the children of the grantor their respective shares of such accumulated amounts;
- (g) That if a sale or sales of said land are made on behalf of the grantor, and the purchaser shall fail to pay the remainder, the trustee may resell such property sold to protect the interest of the beneficiaries, and shall have the title to the same upon the same trusts expressed herein, and shall have the right to resell upon the same conditions;
- (h) That upon all sales made by the trustee he shall have the right to make such building restrictions and restrictions of use as he sees fit which shall best serve to add to the value of all other real estate which he may own and may also in the event of his death designate in his will, possibly such portions as reserved for the benefit of his wife and the minority of the beneficiaries who are children of the grantor as well as himself. No consent by the beneficiaries shall be required in the making of these restrictions.
- (i) Said trustee and his successors shall have the right to make any disposition of said land subject only to the rights of the grantor and to sell with all and singular the rights, franchises, and appurtenances to the said land, subject to all and every claim, right, or interest.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular things contained in and unto the said George F. Tonnes, his successors, heirs and assigns forever, for the uses and purposes set forth in this deed.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the rights, franchises, and appurtenances to the said land, subject to all and every claim, right, or interest of George F. Tonnes, his successors, heirs and assigns or natural or adopted heirs and every person whatsoever lawfully claiming, or to whomsoever he or any part thereof or.
