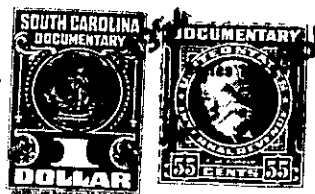

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 125 in Newtown Sub-division as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book "O", at page 21, RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at corner of Meadow Street and Mauldin Street and running thence along Mauldin Street, North 67-04 East 40 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 125 and 126; running thence along the joint line of Lots 125 and 126, North 2-45 West 125 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot 124; running thence South 87-15 West 37.5 feet to an iron pin on Meadow Street; running thence South 2-45 West 138.7 feet to the beginning corner.
