

And I further empower and authorize my said attorney to expend any monies belonging to me for my use and benefit to the end that my support, maintenance and care may be paid for out of my own money and in the discretion of my said attorney. My attorney shall be the sole judge of the necessity for the disbursement of my money.

It is my intention to give my attorney the same power that I myself have over the management of my incoming and my outgoing money, whether in cash or whether represented by commercial paper.
