We, Walter L. Bridwell and Emma Bridwell, owners of a tract of land in Paris Mountain Township do grant and convey to J. H. Bouchillon and Annie Sue Bouchillon, their heirs and assigns, an easement or right-of-way through our land some 75 feet in length, more or less, for the installation of a one-inch water line with the further right to enter upon said premises at reasonable times to make repairs to said line. The Grantees agree to pay to the Grantors any damages which may result from the installation of the above line.

The said J. H. Bouchillon and Annie Sue Bouchillon do hereby agree at any reasonable time on request of the undersigned to change the pipe line as it is now laid to conform to any road which may be laid out through <sup>grantors</sup> property or any other development that they may make of their property.
