presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Earl Parker

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, and being shown as the Eastern portion of
Tract No. 2 on plat of the property of Nellie H Cason, made by
W.J.Riddle, Surveyor in July 1945, and having the following
courses and distances to wit :-

" Beginning at Iron Pin center of junction of Simpsonville and
Fork Shoals road, thence down center of Simpsonville Road in a
northern direction 209 feet to iron pin ; thence along line of
Grantors in an eastern direction 209 feet to iron pin ; thence
in a southern direction 209 feet to iron pin center of Old Hund-
red road, thence in a western direction along Old Hundred Road
209 feet to point of beginning, containing One acre more or less."
