All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, viz., being in Greenville County, containing 0.82 acres, more or less, and being known and designated as lot number four of the plat of J. D. Hood according to plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, June 16, 1952, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of a county road at the joint corner of lots 4 and 5, and running along the line of lot number 5, S. 13-38 W. 285 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots number 4 and 5; thence S. 88-21 E. 128 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of lots 3 and 4; thence along the line of lot number 3, N. 13-38 E. 285 feet to an iron pin on the South side of county road; thence along the right of way of said county road, N. 88-21 E. 128 feet to the beginning corner.
