Lupo, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the North side of Sir Abbot Street, in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as the greater portion of Lot 93 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, August 1951, revised through November 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", at pages 2 and 3, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
