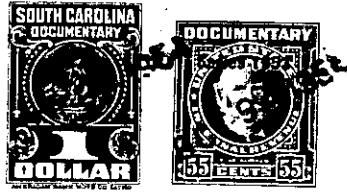

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, School District 265, about three miles
Northwest of the City of Greer, on the Northeast side of Lick
Creek, and being shown and designated as Lot No. 5 on a plat of
the J.M. Wood Estate, prepared by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, February
16, 1954, recorded in Plat Book _ _ _ page _ _ _ , R.M.C. Office
for said County and having the following courses and distances,
to-wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the Southern edge of Wood Road,
joint front corner Lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence as
dividing line between said lots, S 49-30 W four hundred sixty-
six (466) feet to an iron pin or stake on the Northern bank of
Lick Creek, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence
generally with the center of Lick Creek, the following courses
and distances: N 33-44 W one hundred seventy-two and four-tenths
(172.4) feet; N 31-49 W one hundred one and five-tenths (101.5)
feet; N 48-18 W one hundred twenty-two and six-tenths (122.6)
feet; N 43-53 W one hundred seventy-nine and six-tenths (179.6)
feet; N 38-55 W one hundred thirty-six and eight-tenths (136.8)
feet; N 27-05 E one hundred six and eight-tenths (106.8) feet;
thence N 51-35 E one hundred one and three-tenths (101.3) feet
