KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, W. B. Shockley and Ruby S. Shockley

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars and premises

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Roy L. Haynes, Jr. and F. G. Souther

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, quitclaimed, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Roy L. Haynes, Jr. and F. G. Souther, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 18 according to the plat made by Dalton and Neves of the property of Talmer Cordell, April 1, 1951, which plat is recorded in Plat Book "AA", Page 33, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and according to said plat, said lot has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING on the north side of Hampton Circle at the corner of Lot 19, and running thence with the northern side of Hampton Circle N. 43 E. 85 feet to the corner of Lot 17 on said Hampton Circle; thence with Lot 17, N. 47 W. 205 feet to the south side of Pitts Street; thence with the south side of Pitts Street, N. 21 W. 85 feet to the rear corner of Lot 19; thence with Lot 19, S. 49 W. 205 feet to the beginning corner.
