 Fifty-Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100-..... Dollars  
 to..... US..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
 by..... Bertie M. Burns.....  
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..... Bertie M. Burns, her heirs...  
 and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville ~~XXXXXX~~ Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina on the south side of Stall Street and being more  
 particularly described according to Survey and Plat recorded in the R. M. C.  
 Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "HH", page 59 as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of said street at the northwest corner  
 of lot conveyed to the grantee by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-  
 ville County in Deed Book 498, pages 393-396; thence with line of said lot S. 3-53  
 W. 118 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 86-45 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N.  
 3-53 E. 118 feet to an iron pin on said street; thence with said street N. 86-45  
 W. 50 feet to the beginning.

The first Seven grantors named above are children of Ida J. Dempsey as will  
 appear by reference to Apartment 438, File 3, Probate Judge's Office for Green-  
 ville County and the last three grantors are the grandchildren of Ida J. Dempsey,  
 being children of Frank Dempsey, Deceased, a son of Ida J. Dempsey. See deed  
 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. It is the intention of the  
 grantors to convey all of the land that Ida J. Dempsey owned at the time of her  
 death fronting on Stall Street.
