Crow and his heirs and assigns forever:

All of those parcels or lots of land in the City of Greer, in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the East side of Piedmont Avenue, known as Lots Nos. 57 and 58 on a plat of property known as "Morrow Park", which plat is on record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E", at page 91, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Piedmont Avenue—now Memorial Drive—joint corner of lots Nos. 56 and 57, and runs thence with the common line of these two lots S. 78 E. 139 feet to a stake; thence S. 11.30 W. 60 feet to a stake; thence N. 78 W. 138.5 feet to a stake on the East side of Memorial Drive—formerly Piedmont Avenue; thence with the East side of Memorial Drive N. 10.30 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of that lot of land described in deed to the late C.A. Edwards, recorded in Deed Book No. 315, at page 305, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

The above lots of land were devised to the grantor by C.A. Edwards, as appears by his will on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County.
