Bryant and Ruth B. Bryant, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the southern side of Balentine Drive in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot No. 16 of the plat of Greenbrier, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at page 87, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Balentine Drive, which iron pin is the joint corner of Lots 16 and 15 and running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 29-00 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 73-38 E. 66.2 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 16, 12, and 13; running thence along the joint line of Lots 16 and 12 N. 56-50 E. 65 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Balentine Drive; running thence along the southern side of Balentine Drive N. 33-10 W. 108 feet to an iron pin at a curve in Balentine Drive, the chord of which is N. 76-08 W. 55.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the southern side of Balentine Drive S. 61-00 W. 66.7 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

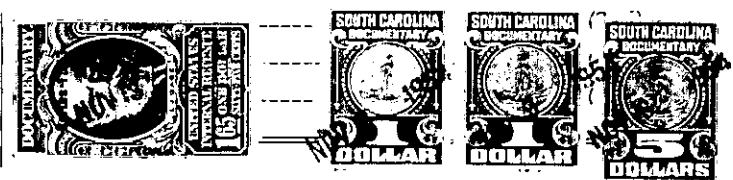
