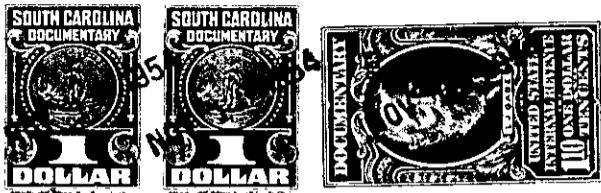

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Hall

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lots 13 and 14,
Block C, subdivision known as Pinehurst, plat of said subdivision is
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book S
at page 77 and according to said plat, when described as a whole,
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Pinehurst Drive,
the same being the joint front corner of lots 12 and 13, and running
thence with the joint line of said lots N. 62-23 E. 137.3 feet to an
iron pin; thence S. 25-58 E. 120 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear
corner of lots 14 and 15, and running thence with the joint line of
said lots S. 62-23 W. 135.6 feet to an iron pin on Pinehurst Drive,
the same being the joint front corner of lots 14 and 15, and running
thence with Pinehurst Drive N. 26-48 W. 120 feet to the beginning
corner.
