WHEREAS, B. O. THOMASON, JR. AND E. M. FRASER

both of Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

TRAVELERS AID SOCIETY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 30th. day of  
November, A. D. 1954 file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is

TRAVELERS AID SOCIETY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to assist needy persons in moving from one community to a other. The Travelers Aid definition of moving persons includes those who are traveling through the community, new comers who have not yet become established in the community, and residents who need assistance in completing travel plans.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: in perpetuity.

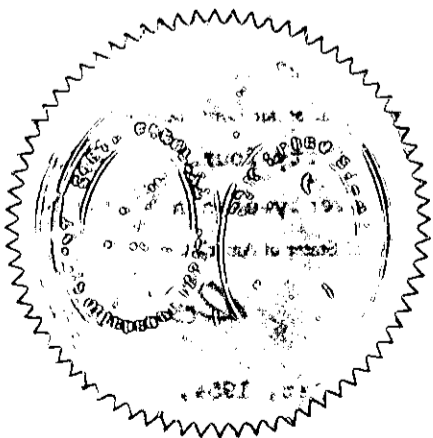
