

All that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, at the northeast corner of Bramlett Road and Holliday Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot # 2 on plat of property of Harold F. Gallivan, et al prepared by Dalton & Neves in July 1952, which is a revision of a plat of the property of A. W. Holliday, recorded in Plat Book F, Page 167, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the northeast corner of Holliday Avenue and Bramlett Road, and running thence with the eastern side of Holliday Avenue, N. 6-45 W. 295.6 feet to a stake at corner of lot 1; thence with line of said lot, N. 83-15 E. 33.7 feet to a stake at corner of property of Duke Power Company; thence with the line of said lot, S. 6-02 E. 295.6 feet to a stake on Bramlett Road; thence with the northern side of Bramlett Road S. 83-15 W. 30 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Tedson, Inc., by Harold F. Gallivan and others by their deed dated October 20, 1954, recorded in Deed Book 512, Page 180.

The lot here conveyed and specifically described heretofore is shown as tract number 2 on a plat of property of Harold F. Gallivan and others dated July 1952 and made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, as revised in July 1953 and is found of record in the office of the R. M. C., in Book HH, Page 193.
