All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being on the Westerly side of Birdfield Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 31 on the plat of Birdfield as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, page 91, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Westerly side of Birdfield Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 30 and 31, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots N 84-43 W 181.3 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly side of a roadway designated on the plat as a private drive; thence along the Easterly side of said drive N 11-40 E 115 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 31 and 32; thence along the joint line of said Lots S 72-44 E 171.8 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly side of Birdfield Drive; thence along the Westerly side of Birdfield Drive S 15-40 W 40 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Westerly side of said Drive S 5-39 E 40 feet to the point of beginning.

This is part of the property conveyed to my husband, L. W. Faris, by the deed recorded in the above mentioned RMC Office in Deed Book 229, page 129, and devised to me by the last will and testament of my husband, now deceased, as will appear in the records of the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, S. As part of the consideration hereof this property is conveyed subject to building restrictions applicable to Birdfield, as recorded in the RMC Office in Deed Book 514, page 505.
