That I, Ernestine M. Massey, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of This is a correction deed to correct deed recorded DOLLARS, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 497 at page 471. to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hugh C. Wood, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about four miles West of the Greenville Courthouse and being located on Mazeey Avenue and having, according to a plat made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers on April 7, 1954, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book HH, page 55, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Mazeey Avenue, said point being the joint corners of this tract of land and property now or formerly owned by R. M. Allen; thence S. 19-05 E. 304 feet to a point in a branch that forms the back line of this tract; thence along the meanders of said branch to a corner in said branch; thence N. 19-05 W. 245 feet along the line of property now or formerly owned by Ernestine M. Massey to an iron pin on the South side of Mazeey Avenue; thence N. 73-09 E. 200 feet along Mazeey Avenue to the point of beginning. Containing 1.3 acres more or less.

The above described property is conveyed subject to the following restrictions:

If the above described property is divided into two lots, 100 feet wide each, the following restrictions shall apply:

- 1. That no structure except a single family dwelling house with one private garage shall be built on each lot described. One such dwelling house to the lot with not less than 1050 feet floor space at a cost not less than \$7500.00. This restriction is for the benefit of the grantor, her heirs and assigns and not for the benefit of the grantee, his heirs and assigns. If the property is not divided, the same restriction shall apply. TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
