CHARTER 1737
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, SAUL ZELMAN AND JACK L. BLOOM

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 30th. day of July, 19 54, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is TEXTILE IRON AND METAL COMPANY, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is SPARTANBURG, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy, sell, acquire, dispose of, deal and trade in and with, at retail or wholesale, new and used metals, metal products, scrap iron, scrap metals, salvage materials of all kinds, industrial waste of all kinds, surplus materials of all kinds, new and used machinery and machinery parts, pipes, paper, cloth, rags, new and used rubber; to wreck, demolish, and acquire buildings and personal property of all kinds, for any purpose, including the purpose of salvaging all junk, iron, metals, and any and all other articles therein contained; and generally to do any and all things necessary, proper, or convenient, pertaining to the conduct and operation of a scrap and waste business, including the owning and leasing of such real estate as may be necessary therefor; and generally to do any and all other acts and things which a corporation may do under the laws of the State of South Carolina

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable in money, labor, or property.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Two Hundred (200) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 29th. day of July, 19 54, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:
Saul Zelman and Jack L. Bloom

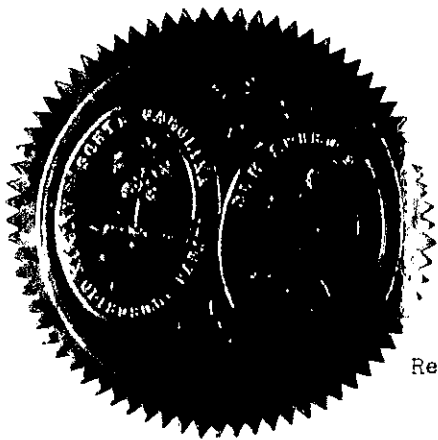
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Saul Zelman ;
as Vice-President, Jack L. Bloom ; as Secretary, Jack L. Bloom ;
as Treasurer, Saul Zelman

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Spartanburg Herald a newspaper published in the County of Spartanburg

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this 30th. day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four and in the one hundred and seventy-ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
