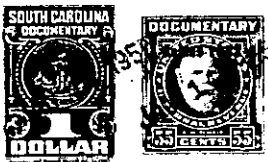

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
C. C. Elliott and C. B. Elliott

All that piece, parcel or lot of land just outside city limits of Greenville near White Horse Road on Easley Highway # 29, in subdivision known as Rolando Hills, according to plat made July 1950 by Piedmont Engineering Company, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in plat Book "AA", at page 71, said lot being number 8, of Block B and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Morrell Drive at the joint corners of lots numbers 7 and 8, thence S. 70 - 54 E. 156 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-56 E. 72.65 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70 - 54 W. 135.9 feet to an iron pin on Morrell Drive; thence S. 19-06 W. 70 feet to an iron pin which is the point of beginning.

This deed is made subject to any rights of way which may have previously been given.

Restrictions:

1. Said lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed to any person of African descent.
2. No residence shall be erected at a cost less than \$3000.00, nor nearer than 25 feet to the front line; nor shall any residence be erected on any lot unless said lot have 50 feet frontage or more.
3. No outside toilets are permitted and sewage must be disposed of by approved septic tank.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
