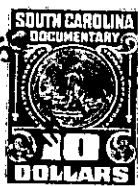

ALL Those certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land lying and being situate in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 200 and an adjoining lot on the northeast, 60 feet wide, Section A, according to plat of property of Woodfields, Inc., prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, and being more particularly shown on plat of property of Anthony J. Brueckner, Jr., dated August 7, 1954, prepared by C. C. Jones, Engineer, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the southeast side of Crestfield Road at the joint front corner of Lots 201 and 200, which iron pin is 100 feet Northeast of Foxhall Road, and running thence along Crestfield Road, N. 51-37 E. 145 feet to a branch; thence turning and running along the branch as the line, S. 26-40 E. 206.3 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 75-30 W. 113 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 200 and 201; thence turning and running along the joint line of said lots, N. 38-23 W. 156.5 feet to an iron pin on Crestfield Road, the point of beginning.
