I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Ralph E. Knight, et al,



on or about the 13th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-four exhibited their County complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Harold E. Knight

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 20th day of January 1955, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Rosa C. Dudley for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. G-206)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$3500.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Rosa C. Dudley

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the east side of Webster St., in the Village of S. Slater and Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 of Block D as shown on a plat of Village of S. Slater and Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Serrine and Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at Pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Webster street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 26 and 27 of Block D, said pin also being 425 feet north from the northeast corner of the intersection of Webster Street and Edison Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 27 N. 87-26 E., 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 7, N. 2-34 W., 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 26, S. 87-26 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Webster Street; thence with the east side of Webster Street S. 2-34 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner."
