leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
M. W. Fore, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville being known and designated as  
Lots Nos. 101, 102, 103 and 104 according to plat of property of  
Walter W. Goldsmith and P. R. Long made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs. in  
May 1944 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County and  
having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Cagle Street and running thence along  
Cagle Street, South 2-45 East 70 feet to an iron pin; running thence  
South 87-15 West 150 feet to an iron pin on a 16-foot alley; running  
thence along said 16-foot alley, North 2-45 West 70 feet to an iron  
pin; running thence North 87-15 West 150 feet to the point of be-  
ginning.

Lots Nos. 101 and 103 face on Cagle Street and Lots 102 and 104 face  
on a 16-foot alley.
