That We, R. M. Allen and H. C. Wood, Jr., in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$1000.00 (one thousand dollars) recorded in Vol. 525, page 271277 R.M.C. Office for Greenville County to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Geneva M. March, Her Heirs and Assigns forever: all our right, title, and interest in and to the following premises:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina about four miles West of the Greenville Court House and being located on Maxey Avenue and having, according to a plat made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers on April 7, 1954, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book HH at page 55, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Maxey Avenue, said point being the joint corners of this tract of land and property now or formerly owned by Cochran; thence along the line of said Cochran property, S. 19-05 E. 246 feet to a point in the middle of a branch whose line forms the back line of this tract; thence along the meanders of said branch to a corner in said branch; thence N. 19-05 W. 304 feet along the line of property now or formerly owned by H. C. Wood, Jr. to an iron pin on Maxey Avenue; thence along the South side of Maxey Avenue 200 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 1.2 acres more or less.

Also: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Maxey Avenue, said point being the joint corners of this tract of land and property now or formerly owned by R. M. Allen; thence S. 19-05 E. 304 feet to a point in a branch that forms the back line of this tract; thence along the meanders of said branch to a corner in said branch; thence N. 19-05 W. 245 feet along the line of property now or formerly owned by Ernestine M. Massey to an iron pin on the South side of Maxey Avenue; thence N. 73-09 E. 200 feet along Maxey Avenue to the point of beginning. Containing 1.3 acres more or less. This being the same property conveyed to the grantors by deed of Ernestine M. Massey dated April 9, 1954.
