In consideration of the premises stated above, and upon the condition that the above stated premises are fulfilled within a reasonable time after the execution of this Deed, the grantor hereby releases and relinquishes unto the grantee, its successors and assigns, the easement or right of way for a 20 foot alley which was reserved over the property now owned by the Northgate Baptist Church in the Deed of C. Douglas Wilson to the predecessor in title of the Northgate Baptist Church, to-wit. Earle Street Baptist Church, in Deed Book 524 at Page 334, and the grantor agrees that the said 20 foot alley or roadway may be abandon and a new 20 foot alley or roadway, as above described, by relocated along the northern side of the property of the Northgate Baptist Church.
