All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, situate and being in Ward One, City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and known and designated as a portion of lots Nos. 6, 7, 8 and 9 of a sub-division of Norwood Property, according to plat made by W. D. Neves, Engineer, May 24, 1920, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the alleyway at joint corner of lots 5 and 6 and running thence parallel with West Washington St. 100 feet to iron pin on line of Catholic Church property; thence along line of Catholic Church property 247 feet, more or less, to iron pin corner; thence along line of the Charles Estate to an iron pin in said alleyway 100 feet, more or less; thence along said alleyway 249.9 feet, more or less, to beginning, SAVING AND EXCEPTING therefrom a 19 ft. strip heretofore conveyed by W. M. Norwood to the City of Greenville for street purposes by deed dated June 12, 1924 and recorded in Deed Book 83 at Page 263, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
