

right of way and easement, along and under said County roads as shown on said plat; and the County does further grant unto the Water Co., its successors and assigns, the right and permit to dig the necessary ditches and excavations for the laying of said water line which shall be necessary for the construction, operation and maintenance of said water line system.

II.

The Water Co. does hereby bind itself, its successors and assigns to do as little damage as possible to the streets and roadways and road sides of said County roads and do hereby further agree to restore the roads of the County or the road side to the equivalent condition that said road was in prior to any excavations for construction or maintenance, now or in the future, and, further agree that the County shall not be responsible for any damages, now or in the future, that may be done or caused by the County, when said County is in the process of maintaining or improving the road side or the roads above mentioned and the employing due care in such operation.
