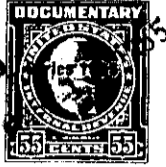

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Palmetto Realty Corporation
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina
and having its principal place of business at
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration
of the sum of Four Hundred and No/100 - - - (\$400.00) - - - Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto ANNALISE C.
GIBSON, HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

"All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in East Gantt Township being known as lot 9 F of a part of Monteith Heights, which said lot is a part of lot 30 of the original plat and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin joint corners of lots 6, 7 and 30 and running thence S. 28-15 E. 102.5 feet to a point at new dead end street thence along North side of said street S. 81-48 W. 97.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 25-15 E. 114.55 feet to point of beginning."

The subdivision of Monteith Heights is shown on a Plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book B, page 185. Lot 9-F is one of the lots in a re-subdivision of Lots 7, 8, 9 and 30 of said Monteith Heights, lot 9-F being in fact a part of Lot 30 of Monteith Heights. The re-subdivision referred to is shown on Plat by Pickell & Pickell, engineers, dated March 11, 1948, not recorded. The new dead end street referred to in the above description is known as Morris Court.

The Grantee agrees to pay 1955 taxes.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the grantee
hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever
