All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 10 on a plat entitled "Map of Springview, Greenville Co., S.C., Property of Effie C. Berry" prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated June, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book BB at page 161, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 9 and 10; thence with the line of Lot 9 N. 10-48 E. 155.8 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot 8; thence with the line of Lot 8 N. 83-46 E. 31 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 8, 10, 12 and 13; thence with the line of Lot 12 S. 15-22 E. 93.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 11 and 12; thence with the line of Lot 11 S. 4-00 E. 93.8 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Farley Avenue; thence with the Northern side of Farley Avenue N. 73-12 W. 95 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
