in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville Rescue Mission, a corporation,

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of West Washington Street and having according to plat of the property of Elizabeth M. Gosnell by W. J. Riddle, surveyor, September, 1949, and to be recorded, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at southwest intersection of West Washington Street and Forest Alley and running thence with West Washington Street N. 48-50 W. 60.1 feet to the outside corner of brick wall, thence with northern face of said wall S. 41-02 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 48-50 E. 60 feet to an iron pin on Forest Alley, thence with Forest Alley N. 41-05 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning, being the same property conveyed to Paul F. Beacham, W. T. Thomas, and G. V. Yonce, as trustees of Greenville Rescue Mission, by Catherine Fewell McNamara, J. D. Poag, and J. E. Gosnell, by deed dated October 1, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Book 445, page 544.
