All my right, title and interest in and to
 all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, lying on the Pelzer Sandy Springs Church Road
 in the Sandy Springs Church community, and being a portion of the lands
 formerly owned by D. L. Garrison and Betty Garrison and having been
 acquired by them under the will of their mother, Sally D. Garrison and
 containing 43.07 acres, more or less, according to survey made by C. O.
 Riddle, Reg. Land Surveyor, in January 1955. It begins in the center of
 the Pelzer-Sandy Springs Church Road a distance of 175 feet northeast
 from the lands of W. H. Campbell which beginning point is the northeast
 corner of a lot owned by Roy W. Garrison and runs thence along the
 center of said road N. 4-15 E. 503 feet, more or less, to corner of lot
 shown as a 6.13 acre tract on the Riddle plat; thence along the line of
 that tract of land N. 73-08 W. 1426 feet to corner on lands formerly
 owned by G. E. Watson; thence along the Watson line S. 36-45 W. 1747.2 feet
 feet to stone; thence N. 82-55 E. along the W. H. Campbell line 1884
 feet to corner on the Roy W. Garrison lot previously referred to; thence
 along line of Roy W. Garrison N. 1-55 E. 175 feet to corner; thence con-
 tinuing along the Roy W. Garrison tract N. 82-55 E. 503.3 feet to the
 beginning corner and containing 43.07 acres, more or less.
