County, State of South Carolina on the Pelzer - Sandy Springs Church Road in the

Sandy Springs Church Road vicinity and being a portion of the lands formerly owned by D. L. Garrison and Betty Garrison now deceased and having been acquired by them under the will of their mother, Sally D. Garrison and containing in the aggregate 69 acres, more or less, according to survey made by C. O. Riddle, Reg. Land Surveyor, in January 1955 and shown on that plat as three parcels, one of which contains 6.13 acres, another 25.95 acres, and the third 36.92 acres, and being bounded on the north by lands now or formerly of C. E. Watson and Campbell, on the east by Campbell, on the south by Campbell and a tract of land formerly belonging to D. L. Garrison and Betty Garrison, but being conveyed to the said D. L. Garrison. It begins on the line of C. E. Watson lands at the northwest corner of the tract being conveyed to D. L. Garrison and runs thence along Watson line N. 36-45 E. 207.5 feet to iron pin; thence continuing along the same course 1190 feet to iron pin on Campbell's line; thence along Campbell's line S. 55-42 E. 1050 feet to center of the Pelzer-Sandy Springs Church Road; thence continuing on the same course 1482 feet to iron pin on W. E. Campbell's land; thence along Campbell's line S. 40-55 W. 871 feet to corner; thence S. 82-55 W. 1044.7 feet to corner in center of Pelzer-Sandy Springs Church Road; thence along the center of said road N. 1-55 E. 175 feet; thence continuing along the center of said road; N. 4-15 E. 503 feet to corner on the
