Beulah H. McDonald, her heirs or assigns:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 5.3 acres, more or less, according to survey and plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Reg. Land Surveyor, in April, 1951 and constituting a portion of tracts numbers 9 and 10 of the J. M. Verdin lands and having been conveyed to W. H. Beattie Coker in part by a deed of J. M. Verdin dated March 23, 1941, recorded in Deed Book 231, Page 117 and in part by a deed from J. P. Verdin and D. P. Verdin dated December 9, 1943, recorded in Deed Book 259, Page 189. The parcel of land here conveyed begins at an iron pin on McDonald's land and runs thence along the property of Bayne H. 82-30 E. 685 feet to corner on edge of branch; thence S. 35-15 E. 172 feet to corner; thence S. 74-30 E. 100 feet to another corner; thence by a dividing line cutting off the property here conveyed from the lands of Coker S. 72-02 W. 1036 feet to iron pin on McDonald; thence N. 15-06 E. 400 feet to the beginning corner.
